

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

August 2013

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey for the week ended August 17, 2013, there were 564,900 persons employed in Saskatchewan during August 2013, an increase of 800 from July 2013 and 15,800 more than the number employed in August 2012.

Agricultural employment was 44,900 persons in August 2013, up 1,500 from the July 2013 level and 1,700 more than the August 2012 agricultural employment level of 43,200. Non-agricultural employment was 520,000 persons in August 2013. This is a decrease of 700 from the July 2013 non-agriculture employment level of 520,700 but 14,100 more than August 2012.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for August 2013 was 5.0 percent. This is an increase of 0.5 percentage points from the July 2013 rate of 4.5 percent but 0.2 percentage points lower than the August 2012 level of 5.2 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 4,300 to 594,800 persons in August 2013 from 590,500 persons in July 2013. This is 15,400 more than the August 2012 labour force of 579,400 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.4 percentage points to 71.8 percent in August 2013 from 71.4 percent in July 2013. The August 2012 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 71.3 percent.

There were 29,900 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during August 2013. This is an increase of 3,400 from July 2013 but is 400 less than the number unemployed in August 2012.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 558,700 persons employed in Saskatchewan in August 2013, down 600 from the July 2013 level of 559,300 but up 15,600 from the August 2012 employment level of 543,100 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for August 2013 was 4.2 percent. This is an increase of 0.2 percentage points from the July 2013 rate of 4.0 percent but 0.2 percentage points lower than the August 2012 rate of 4.4 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment increased by 24,900 persons in August 2013 to 18,027,600 persons from 18,002,700 persons in July 2013. In August 2012, there were 17,769,000 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.2 percentage points in August 2013 to 7.6 percent from the July 2013 level of 7.4 percent. In August 2012, Canada's unemployment rate was 7.8 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.1 percent in August 2013. This is 0.1 percentage points lower than July 2013 and 0.2 percentage points lower than the August 2012 level of 7.3 percent.
