

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

October 2013

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey for the week ended October 19, 2013, there were 556,500 persons employed in Saskatchewan during October 2013, an increase of 1,000 from September 2013 and 14,900 more than the number employed in October 2012.

Agricultural employment was 45,500 persons in October 2013, down 2,000 from the September 2013 level but 1,800 more than the October 2012 agricultural employment level of 43,700. Non-agricultural employment was 511,000 persons in October 2013. This is an increase of 3,000 from the September 2013 non-agriculture employment level of 508,000 and 13,100 more than October 2012.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for October 2013 was 3.1 percent. This is a decrease of 0.7 percentage points from the September 2013 rate of 3.8 percent and 0.9 percentage points lower than the October 2012 level of 4.0 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 3,000 to 574,300 persons in October 2013 from 577,300 persons in September 2013. This is 9,800 more than the October 2012 labour force of 564,500 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 0.5 percentage points to 69.1 percent in October 2013 from 69.6 percent in September 2013. The October 2012 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 69.3 percent.

There were 17,800 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during October 2013. This is a decrease of 4,000 from September 2013 and is 5,000 less than the number unemployed in October 2012.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 557,800 persons employed in Saskatchewan in October 2013, up 2,300 from the September 2013 level of 555,500 and up 16,900 from the October 2012 employment level of 540,900 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for October 2013 was 3.6 percent. This is a decrease of 0.7 percentage points from the September 2013 rate of 4.3 percent and 1.0 percentage points lower than the October 2012 rate of 4.6 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 19,000 persons in October 2013 to 17,829,200 persons from 17,848,200 persons in September 2013. In October 2012, there were 17,627,600 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.1 percentage points in October 2013 to 6.5 percent from the September 2013 level of 6.4 percent. In October 2012, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.7 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 6.9 percent in October 2013. This is unchanged from September 2013 and 0.5 percentage points lower than the October 2012 level of 7.4 percent.
