

# Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

November 2014

## UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering November 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>, 2014, there were 567,600 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 8,600 from October 2014 but 15,300 more than the number employed in November 2013.

Agricultural employment was 42,200 persons in November 2014, down 5,600 from the October 2014 level but unchanged from November. Non-agricultural employment was 525,400 persons in November 2014. This is a decrease of 3,000 from the October 2014 non-agriculture employment level of 528,400 but 15,300 more than November 2013.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for November 2014 was 3.2 percent. This is an increase of 0.3 percentage points from the October 2014 rate of 2.9 percent but 0.6 percentage points lower than the November 2013 level of 3.8 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 7,100 to 586,200 persons in November 2014 from 593,300 persons in October 2014. This is 11,900 more than the November 2013 labour force of 574,300 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 0.9 percentage points to 69.2 percent in November 2014 from 70.1 percent in October 2014. The November 2013 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 68.9 percent.

There were 18,600 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during November 2014. This is an increase of 1,500 from October 2014 but is 3,300 less than the number unemployed in November 2013.

## SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 572,100 persons employed in Saskatchewan in November 2014, down 3,900 from the October 2014 level of 576,000 but is up 15,200 from the November 2013 employment level of 556,900 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for November 2014 was 3.4 percent. This is a decrease of 0.1 percentage points from the October 2014 rate of 3.5 percent but 0.7 percentage points lower than the November 2013 rate of 4.1 percent.

## CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 58,400 persons in November 2014 to 17,961,700 persons from 18,020,100 persons in October 2014. In November 2013, there were 17,800,000 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 0.2 percentage points in November 2014 to 6.2 percent from the October 2014 level of 6.0 percent. In November 2013, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.4 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 6.6 percent in November 2014. This is 0.1 percentage points higher than October 2014 but 0.3 percentage points higher/lower than the November 2013 level of 6.9 percent.
