

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

October 2014

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering October 12th to 18th, 2014, there were 576,200 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is an increase of 1,400 from September 2014 and 19,700 more than the number employed in October 2013.

Agricultural employment was 47,800 persons in October 2014, down 3,500 from the September 2014 level but 2,300 more than the October 2013 agricultural employment level of 45,500. Non-agricultural employment was 528,400 persons in October 2014. This is an increase of 4,900 from the September 2014 non-agriculture employment level of 523,500 and 17,400 more than October 2013.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for October 2014 was 2.9 percent. This is unchanged from September and 0.2 percentage points lower than the October 2013 level of 3.1 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 1,400 to 593,300 persons in October 2014 from 591,900 persons in September 2014. This is 19,000 more than the October 2013 labour force of 574,300 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.1 percentage points to 70.1 percent in October 2014 from 70.0 percent in September 2014. The October 2013 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 69.1 percent.

There were 17,100 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during October 2014. This is unchanged from September 2014 and is 700 less than the number unemployed in October 2013.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 576,000 persons employed in Saskatchewan in October 2014, up 2,300 from the September 2014 level of 573,700 and is up 18,400 from the October 2013 employment level of 557,600 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for October 2014 was 3.5 percent. This is unchanged from September 2014 rate and 0.2 percentage points lower than the October 2013 rate of 3.7 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment increased by 10,000 persons in October 2014 to 18,020,100 persons from 18,010,100 persons in September 2014. In October 2013, there were 17,829,200 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 0.2 percentage points in October 2014 to 6.0 percent from the September 2014 level of 6.2 percent. In October 2013, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.5 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 6.5 percent in October 2014. This is 0.3 percentage points lower than September 2014 and 0.5 percentage points lower than the October 2013 level of 7.0 percent.
