

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

August 2015

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering August 9th to 15th, 2015, there were 578,700 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is an increase of 3,400 from July 2015 and 1,600 more than the number employed in August 2014.

Agricultural employment was 42,000 persons in August 2015, down 300 from the July 2015 level and 6,500 less than the August 2014 agricultural employment level of 48,500. Non-agricultural employment was 536,700 persons in August 2015. This is an increase of 3,700 from the July 2015 non-agriculture employment level of 533,000 and 8,100 more than August 2014.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for August 2015 was 6.0 percent. This is an increase of 0.6 percentage points from the July 2015 rate of 5.4 percent and 0.8 percentage points higher than the August 2014 level of 5.2 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 7,200 to 615,500 persons in August 2015 from 608,300 persons in July 2015. This is 6,700 more than the August 2014 labour force of 608,800 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.7 percentage points to 71.3 percent in August 2015 from 70.6 percent in July 2015. The August 2014 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 71.3 percent.

There were 36,800 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during August 2015. This is an increase of 3,800 from July 2015 and is 5,100 more than the number unemployed in August 2014.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 572,700 persons employed in Saskatchewan in August 2015, up 4,000 from the July 2015 level of 568,700 and is up 1,500 from the August 2014 employment level of 571,200 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for August 2015 was 4.7 percent. This is a decrease of 0.5 percentage points from the July 2015 rate of 5.2 percent and 0.6 percentage points higher than the August 2014 rate of 4.1 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 11,500 persons in August 2015 to 18,228,800 persons from 18,240,300 persons in July 2015. In August 2014, there were 18,037,800 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.4 percentage points in August 2015 to 7.5 percent from the July 2015 level of 7.1 percent. In August 2014, Canada's unemployment rate was 7.5 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.0 percent in August 2015. This is 0.2 percentage points higher than July 2015 and remained unchanged from the August 2014 level of 7.0 percent.
