

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

October 2015

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering October 11th to 17th, 2015, there were 580,000 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is an increase of 600 from September 2015 and 600 more than the number employed in October 2014.

Agricultural employment was 44,100 persons in October 2015, down 100 from the September 2015 level and 2,800 less than the October 2014 agricultural employment level of 46,900. Non-agricultural employment was 535,900 persons in October 2015. This is an increase of 700 from the September 2015 non-agriculture employment level of 535,200 and 3,400 more than October 2014.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for October 2015 was 4.9 percent. This is an increase of 0.5 percentage points from the September 2015 rate of 4.4 percent and 1.9 percentage points higher than the October 2014 level of 3.0 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 4,100 to 609,900 persons in October 2015 from 605,800 persons in September 2015. This is 12,300 more than the October 2014 labour force of 597,600 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.4 percentage points to 70.6 percent in October 2015 from 70.2 percent in September 2015. The October 2014 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 69.9 percent.

There were 29,900 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during October 2015. This is an increase of 3,500 from September 2015 and is 11,700 more than the number unemployed in October 2014.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 577,300 persons employed in Saskatchewan in October 2015, up 1,400 from the September 2015 level of 575,900 but is down 300 from the October 2014 employment level of 577,600 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for October 2015 was 5.6 percent. This is an increase of 0.5 percentage points from the September 2015 rate of 5.1 percent and 2.0 percentage points higher than the October 2014 rate of 3.6 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment increased by 25,600 persons in October 2015 to 18,094,300 persons from 18,068,700 persons in September 2015. In October 2014, there were 17,948,600 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 0.1 percentage points in October 2015 to 6.3 percent from the September 2015 level of 6.4 percent. In October 2014, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.0 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.0 percent in October 2015. This is 0.1 percentage points lower than September 2015 but 0.4 percentage points higher than the October 2014 level of 6.6 percent.
