

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

January 2017

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering January 15th to 21st, 2017, there were 558,600 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 4,400 from December 2016 and 4,800 less than the number employed in January 2016.

Agricultural employment was 37,000 persons in January 2017, down 400 from the December 2016 level and 1,600 less than the January 2016 agricultural employment level of 38,600. Non-agricultural employment was 521,600 persons in January 2017. This is a decrease of 4,000 from the December 2016 non-agriculture employment level of 525,600 and 3,200 less than January 2016.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for January 2017 was 7.1 percent. This is an increase of 0.9 percentage points from the December 2016 rate of 6.2 percent and 1.0 percentage points higher than the January 2016 level of 6.1 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 1,100 to 601,400 persons in January 2017 from 600,300 persons in December 2016. This is 1,500 more than the January 2016 labour force of 599,900 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.1 percentage points to 68.9 percent in January 2017 from 68.8 percent in December 2016. The January 2016 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 69.3 percent.

There were 42,800 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during January 2017. This is an increase of 5,400 from December 2016 and is 6,200 more than the number unemployed in January 2016.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 567,500 persons employed in Saskatchewan in January 2017, down 700 from the December 2016 level of 568,200 and down 4,800 from the January 2016 employment level of 572,300 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for January 2017 was 6.4 percent. This is a decrease of 0.1 percentage points from the December 2016 rate of 6.5 percent but 0.8 percentage points higher than the January 2016 rate of 5.6 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 176,900 persons in January 2017 to 17,956,100 persons from 18,133,000 persons in December 2016. In January 2016, there were 17,661,900 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.8 percentage points in January 2017 to 7.2 percent from the December 2016 level of 6.4 percent. In January 2016, Canada's unemployment rate was 7.5 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 6.8 percent in January 2017. This is 0.1 percentage points lower than December 2016 and 0.4 percentage points lower than the January 2016 level of 7.2 percent.
