

# Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

October 2016

## UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering October 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016, there were 569,200 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 4,200 from September 2016 and 10,800 less than the number employed in October 2015.

Agricultural employment was 39,200 persons in October 2016, down 4,500 from the September 2016 level and 4,900 less than the October 2015 agricultural employment level of 44,100. Non-agricultural employment was 530,000 persons in October 2016. This is an increase of 300 from the September 2016 non-agriculture employment level of 529,700 but 5,900 less than October 2015.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for October 2016 was 6.1 percent. This is an increase of 0.2 percentage points from the September 2016 rate of 5.9 percent and 1.2 percentage points higher than the October 2015 level of 4.9 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 3,700 to 605,800 persons in October 2016 from 609,500 persons in September 2016. This is 4,100 less than the October 2015 labour force of 609,900 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 0.5 percentage points to 69.5 percent in October 2016 from 70.0 percent in September 2016. The October 2015 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 70.6 percent.

There were 36,700 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during October 2016. This is an increase of 600 from September 2016 and 6,800 more than the number unemployed in October 2015.

## SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 566,900 persons employed in Saskatchewan in October 2016, down 2,400 from the September 2016 level of 569,300 and down 10,600 from the October 2015 employment level of 577,500 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for October 2016 was 6.9 percent. This is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from the September 2016 rate of 6.8 percent and 1.2 percentage points higher than the October 2015 rate of 5.7 percent.

## CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment increased by 44,600 persons in October 2016 to 18,256,700 persons from 18,212,100 persons in September 2016. In October 2015, there were 18,094,300 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 0.1 percentage points in October 2016 to 6.3 percent from the September 2016 level of 6.4 percent. In October 2015, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.3 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.0 percent in October 2016. This is remained unchanged from both September 2016 and October 2015 level of 7.0 percent.
